

This past year, we were able to move forward with several infrastructure projects including a new road for the training grounds and the purchase of a new fire truck. Programmatically, we have launched a new YouTube page, and have developed several new online offerings. With the implementation of new space restrictions and Covid protocols, we were able to deliver 3,417 courses. These courses provided training for 34,281 emergency responders throughout the state of Oklahoma.

OSU-FST was able to secure several grants for the upcoming year: 1) A new four-year safer training grant that will allow us to continue to train our rural departments throughout the state. 2) We were also awarded another OSHA, Susan Harwood training grant that will fund another year of grain rescue training. 3) We are very proud to be partners with OEM on the HMEP training grant, and 4) Department of Homeland security who funds training for Hazardous Materials and Rescue programs.

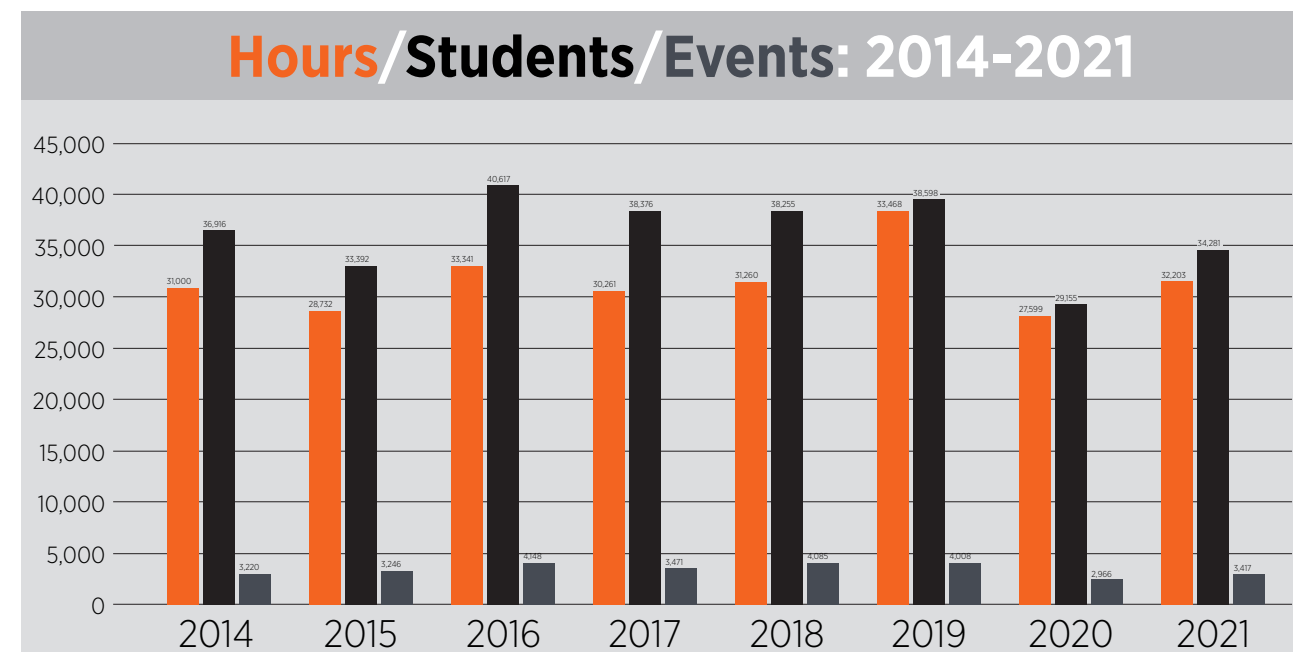
Our state allocations continue to shrink, and we have been working hard to pursue grants and other partnerships to keep providing training. OSU-FST works hard to keep costs low. We are currently working on updating our facilities at our training grounds. The 1980 facility is in need of some major upgrades to ensure the high-caliber training continues.

Snell, the new EMS program coordinator, Ashley Peck, who is answering phones and taking care of our travel arrangements, and Mike Weinkauff who is our new driver that will be delivering and supporting our mobile trailers, Tara Youngblood is also joining our team as the Accreditation Manager. Our latest hire is Troy Thorpe, he will be our volunteer fire representative for the Northeast section of the state. Thank you to all of our staff for all the hours worked, miles driven and the long days, frustration felt and huge amount of pride that you put into each and every work day bringing innovative, high-quality training to the state of Oklahoma.

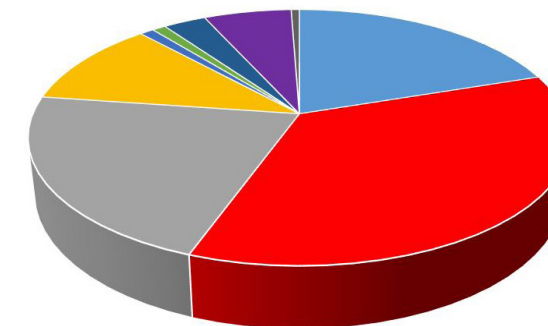
