

The Fire Emergency Services Training Center travels the state of Oklahoma in support of training courses conducted for Oklahoma firefighters and other emergency responders. OSUFST received an assistance to firefighters grant in the amount of \$230,000 to purchase 30 new pieces of self-contained breathing apparatus (SCBA) and 40 sets of personal protective equipment (PPE) to be used by OSU FST instructors while conducting live fire and rescue training.




