



Oklahoma State University Fire Service Training (OSU FST) was recently awarded an Assistance to Firefighters grant for a mobile, live-fire, liquefied petroleum gas simulator. This is a multipurpose simulator that will allow OSU FST to provide live-fire training that meets NFPA 1001 certification requirements for both Firefighters I and II. This prop also allows FST to take this training to rural areas where training facilities are not always available to fire departments. With this unit, OSU FST will be able to provide specialized training in the areas of controlling propane tank impingement fires, flammable liquid spill fires, pipeline valve flange fires and vehicle fires.


