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### INSTRUCTIONS TO THE CANDIDATE

While operating as an individual, will: respond on an apparatus, safely mount apparatus, safely dismount apparatus, wear PPE, identify scene hazards and deploy traffic control devices. Candidates will wear full PPE.

#### EMERGENCY RESPONSE

**Evaluator, acting as company officer, tells candidate: “We are receiving an emergency call and need to respond to an automobile accident on the freeway.”**

Candidate has informed the evaluator that they have been trained in this skill ♦				
Dons PPE prior to response				
Fastens seat belts prior to vehicle going into motion.				
Hearing protection worn (this can be apparatus mounted hearing protection.)				
Prior to apparatus moving, candidate communicates to the evaluator that they are ready to respond.				

**Apparatus moves forward to simulate response and comes to stop at scenario location.**

Checks for oncoming traffic and hazards before dismounting apparatus.				
Dismounts apparatus without tripping, falling or jumping.				

#### SCENE CONTROL

**Evaluator, acting as company officer, tells candidate: “You have arrived on scene and you need to create a safety zone behind the apparatus using traffic control devices.”**

Deploys traffic control devices. (i.e. cones)				
Reports to company officer when task is completed.				

#### HAZARD MITIGATION

**Evaluator, acting as company officer, tells candidate: “A downed power line (residential neighborhood) has been located and you need to minimize the hazard by placing scene control devices around the hazard. Make sure that you approach with caution and do not get any closer to downed wires than necessary.”**

Places scene control devices to isolate hazard (cones or other barrier devices).				
Reports to company officer when task is completed.
