| DEPLOY SALVAGE COVERS | | | | | | | | | | | | |
| Evaluator acting as company officer tells candidates "Cluster furniture in this room and deploy salvage covers to protect occupant's belongings from water that is leaking from the ceiling. You need to deploy the salvage cover with the balloon throw method." | | | | | | | | | | | | |
| Clusters furniture so that one salvage cover will cover furniture and protect from further water damage. | | | | | | | | | | | | |
| Deploys salvage cover using the "balloon throw" method | | | | | | | | | | | | |
| Covers furniture with salvage cover so that they are protected | | | | | | | | | | | | |
| CATCHALLS AND WATER CHUTES | | | | | | | | | | | | |
| Evaluator acting as company officer tells candidates "Water is now flowing heavily from ceiling and needs to be diverted out of structure using a water chute and catch all" | | | | | | | | | | | | |
| Salvage cover that is going to be made into catchall is immediately placed under leak while catchall is being constructed. | | | | | | | | | | | | |
| Catchall is constructed so that it will hold water without draining | | | | | | | | | | | | |
| Verbalize how they would remove water when catchall fills up | | | | | | | | | | | | |
| Evaluator acting as company officer tells candidates "Catchall is filling up and the water vacuum is no longer working. You need to construct a water chute using a folding type ladder, pike poles and salvage covers. The leaking water needs to flow by gravity out a nearby window or door." | | | | | | | | | | | | |
| Gathers all equipment and construct water chute so that water leak is diverted out of structure through door or window. | | | | | | | | | | | | |
| Water chute is constructed so that gravity will carry the leaking water out of structure. | | | | | | | | | | | | |
| CLEANING AND INSPECTION OF SALVAGE COVERS | | | | | | | | | | | | |
| Evaluator acting as company officer tells candidates "Loss is stopped and all salvage covers need to be returned to service" | | | | | | | | | | | | |
| Removes salvage covers and lay flat on floor | | | | | | | | | | | | |
| Evaluator asks candidates "After returning to station what would you do with salvage covers?" | | | | | | | | | | | | |
| Verbalizes how they would clean salvage covers, inspect for damage and dry before placing them back in service. Candidates verbalize what type of fold/roll they would perform to place salvage cover back in service. | | | | | | | | | | | | |
