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INSTRUCTIONS TO THE CANDIDATE

The candidate, given various equipment, will coordinate a simulated interior attack line for team's accomplishment of an assignment in a structure fire, given attack lines, personnel, personal protective equipment, and tools, so that crew integrity is established; attack techniques are selected for the given level of the fire, attack techniques are communicated to the attack teams, constant team coordination is maintained, fire growth and development is continuously evaluated, search, rescue, and ventilation requirements are communicated or managed, hazards are reported to the attack teams, and incident command is apprised of changing conditions.
