Don SCBA facepiece and ensure proper fit and seal.				
Pulls hood up completely so that facepiece straps and skin are not exposed.				
Don helmet and secures.				
Don gloves.				
Ensure that all fasteners, straps, buckles, etc. are fastened.				
Ensure no skin is exposed.				
◆ Candidates breathes from SCBA and ensures SCBA is functioning properly.
