Objective(s): **7.4.2(4) NFPA Standard 472 2008 Edition**

### INSTRUCTIONS TO THE PROCTOR/EVALUATOR

1. Candidate must indicate that they have been instructed how to perform this skill. A negative answer is an immediate failure. No second attempt is allowed. This step doesn't count for the total number of steps the candidate must complete.
2. Evaluator must provide vapor protective clothing and SCBA and mask in good condition.
3. Each candidate shall perform work activities as determined by the Proctor before doffing this equipment.
4. Specific tasks, i.e., donning, are not timed but the candidate must complete the station within the maximum allowable time. Evaluator may assist or may assign another candidate to assist the candidate with closing and opening the suit and donning and doffing boots. The candidate being evaluated must instruct the person assisting as to what he/she wants done. No additional discussion between candidates is allowed.

***\*Note: If the candidate must complete other skill station/s dressed in the PPE they have donned within this station, they may complete the doffing portion of this skill sheet after completing the additional stations.***
