INSTRUCTIONS TO THE CANDIDATE								
The candidate shall demonstrate the inspection, donning, working-in and doffing of liquid splash protective clothing.

◆ Candidate has informed the evaluator that they have been trained in this skill.								
Candidate properly inspects splash protective clothing.								
Inspect the seam tape for lifts or delamination.								
Inspect the visor lens for a tight seal and clear vision (if applicable)								
Inspect the glove system to make sure they are in good condition and are free from holes, cuts, wear cracks, or any other questionable markings.								
Inspect the suit zipper or closure system, making sure it is in good working condition and performs as intended.								
Inspect the suit material for any signs of deterioration such as cracks, holes or discoloration.								
Candidate properly don splash protective clothing.								
While seated, places both legs into suit, pulls the suit up until both feet are through the leg openings of the garment.								
Place both feet into outer work boots, and pull boot flap down over the top of the outer work boots. (Tape optional)								
Place arms inside the suit and secures the opening.								
Properly don SCBA and mask. Breathes normally.								
Don latex gloves and outer work gloves, and pulls suit arm openings over gloves (tape optional).								
Pull suit hood over head so that straps and skin are covered. (Tape optional)								
Breathes normally.
