

GRAIN BIN AWARENESS EMERGENCIES

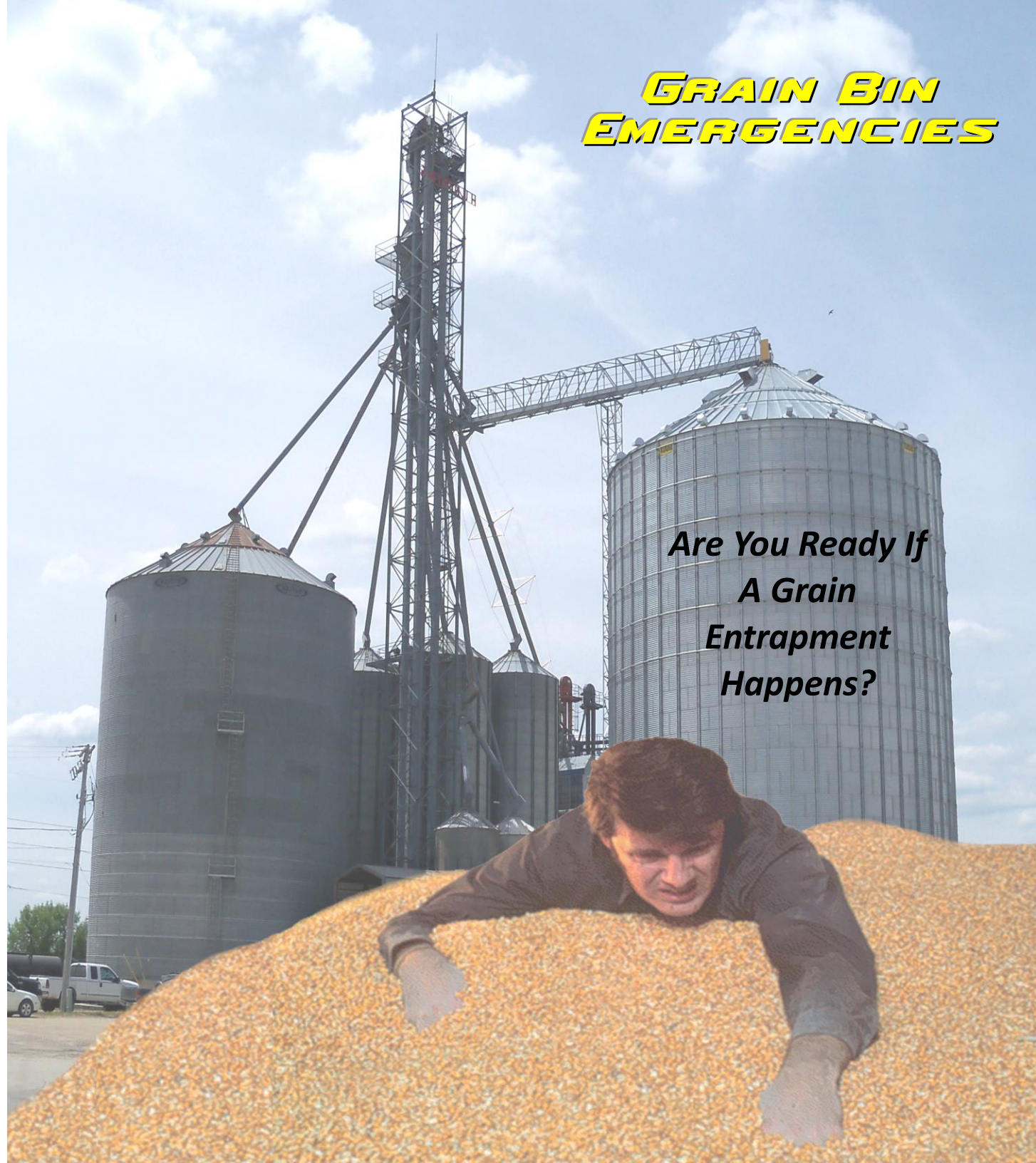
