Students are responsible for bringing NFPA compliant bunker gear, including coat, pants, boots, gloves and flashover hood & helmet. OSU-FST will provide SCBA's for those who cannot bring their own. Lodging and meals other than lunch will be the responsibility of the student. Class size is limited to the first 28 who reserve slots. Please understand that firefighting is physically demanding work. Medical monitoring will be provided on site before live burns and as needed.
