OSU-FST will provide SCBA's for those who cannot bring their own. Lodging and meals other than lunch will be the responsibility of the student.



** Please understand that fireground activities and training are physically demanding. Medical monitoring will be provided on site before live burn exercise and as needed. All students participating in live burn exercises and wearing respiratory protection are required to be clean shaven per OSHA and NFPA.*
