3. Dons hearing protection (This can be apparatus mounted hearing protection.).				
4. Prior to apparatus moving, candidate shall communicate to the company officer that they are ready to respond.				
<b>Apparatus moves forward to simulate response and comes to a stop at scenario location.</b>				
5. Checks for oncoming traffic or other hazards before dismounting.				
6. Dismounts apparatus safely.				
<b>SCENE CONTROL</b>				
<b>Evaluator tells candidate: “You have arrived on scene and you need to create a safety zone behind the apparatus using traffic control devices.”</b>

<b>HAZARD MITIGATION</b>
